

# 2015-2016 SAT and ACT Test Dates

Official test dates have been announced for the 2015-2016 SAT and ACT exam administrations. Many colleges and universities across the country will accept scores from either the SAT OR ACT exams as a requirement for college admission. Writing portions are optional for both exams. Keep in mind that many competitive schools (Ivy Leagues, Georgetown, MIT, Wellesley College, Johns Hopkins, etc.) and competitive programs are likely to require students to submit SAT Subject Test scores. I encourage students to consult the websites of their potential schools of choice prior to selecting which exam to take.

## **Please make Note of test dates and registration deadlines to avoid late fees.**

Important changes have occurred with the SAT. The current SAT will only be available through January of 2016. Seniors should take current exam as they have had more preparation for this version. As of March of 2016, the new redesigned SAT will be offered. Juniors and Sophomores should take this version of the exam. The new SAT will offer an optional essay. Students are strongly encouraged to check directly with their potential post-secondary school of choice for specific requirements. The SAT test fee is \$54.50 with the essay portion and \$43.00 without the essay portion. SAT Registrations after the below deadlines will incur a late fee of an additional \$28.00. First time test takers will not be able to register until the start of school when new paper registrations have been received on campus. Paper registrants do not qualify for late registration. Previous Sunday test takers may register @ collegeboard.org using their College Board account information. These testers also qualify for late registration with an added late fee. SAT HS code is 100985 and our test center number is 01000.

For the ACT, it is not mandatory that students take the writing portion but as stated above, students should check directly with their potential post-secondary school of choice for specific requirements. SDA post-secondary schools do not require the writing portion. This ACT with no Writing exam cost is \$39.50 with writing the cost is \$56.50. ACT registrations after the below deadlines will incur an additional late fee of \$24. Students can register at any time online @ actstudent.org. At the beginning of the registration process, students should choose the Saturday test date. Once you have chosen FLA as the test center and the registration process is complete, the Saturday test date will revert to the Sunday date immediately following the noted Saturday date. Our HS code is 100985 and our test center number is 172791.
